### XVI MEĐUNARODNI POZORIŠNI FESTIVAL „SLAVIJA“ 2017.

Svake godine u osvit ranog proleća, 9. marta, počinje Međunarodni pozorišni festival „Slavija“ sa ponudom odabranih predstava u izvođenju teatarskih ansambala sa raznih strana sveta. Gledaoci su već navikli da festivalski program nije ni tematski niti stilski omeđen bilo kakvim opredeljenjima, niti je obeležen traganjem za novim izvođačkim tendencijama ili eksperimentalnim predstavama. Jednostavno rečeno, radi se o festivalu dobrih predstava realizovanim na dramskim tekstovima proverene vrednosti, najčešće iz pera poznatih pisaca. Zato se i ove godine može reći da će Festival „Slavija“ omogućiti gledaocima susrete sa delima poznatih svetskih dramatičara sa pozorišnih scena osam zemalja. Već prve festivalske večeri, 9. marta, rusko Akademsko omladinsko pozorište iz Rostova na Donu prikazće na našim scenama neizvođen komad uglednog francuskog savremenog dramatičara Erik-Emanuela Šmita *Gospodin Ibrahim* o doživljajima jednoga dečaka na putu od Pariza do Istambula, dok će druge večeri, 10. marta, Republičko pozorište Beloruske drame iz Minska predstaviti delo poznatoga švedskoga pisca Augusta Strindberga *Pelikan*. Reč je o delu iz pišećeg ciklusa kamernih drama koje kod nas nije uopšte izvođeno, tako da se može reći kako Festival počinje u znaku repertoarskih ekskluziviteta.

Treća festivalska predstava, koja se izvodi 11. marta, ponikla je na bogatoj tradiciji istočnačkoga teatra senki. Pozorište Bariš iz Marageha u Iranu prikazće predstavu *Senke i vетар* Ferejdona Velaeija, koju je autor i režirao. U pitanju je vesela igra protagoniste sa sopstvenom senkom u kojima se obrađuju brojni problemi egzistencije savremenoga čoveka. I četvrte večeri, 12. marta, ostajemo u svetu velike literature: tada nastupa Eksperimentalno dramsko pozorište nacionalnosti iz Moskve i prikazuje priču Fjodora Dostojevskog *San smešnog čoveka* čiji se junak bavi rešavanjem i danas aktuelnih životnih problema.

Pete večeri, 13. marta, domaćin Festivala, Pozorište „Slavija“, prikazće novitet sa svoga repertoara – dramu najznačajnijeg srpskog komediografa Branislava Đ. Nušića *Žena bez srca*, koja se može tretirati kao nadrealistički dramski ogled, što u ovoj predstavi na sceni uspešno dokazuje reditelj Slavenko Saletović. Naredne, šeste festivalske večeri, 14. marta, nastupiće Državno dramsko pozorište „Stojan Bačvarov“ iz Varne sa predstavom drame *Jednooki kralj* savremenog španskog spisatelja Marka Krehueta u kojoj se obrađuje problematika savremenog političkoga života.

Estonsko pozorište R.A.A.M. iz Talina prikazuje sedme festivalske večeri, 15. marta, komad Augusta Kicberga *Vukodlak* u kojem se raspravlja o stanju duha u jednoj seoskoj sredini nakon spaljivanja neke mlade žene proglašene za vešticu. Završne, osme večeri XVI međunarodnog pozorišnog festivala „Slavija“ Žambiljsko regionalno rusko dramsko pozorište iz Žambilja u Kazahstanu prikazće komad *Neron i ja*, Edvarda Radzinskog, u kojem se prikazuje Neronovo zločinstvo prema zaverenicima koji su ustali protiv njegove krvave vladavine, zbog čega ih ovaj surovi vladar kažnjava smrću, prisiljavajući svoga učitelja Senku da posmatra pogubljenje.

Gledaćemo drame koje prikazuju životne prilike i sukobe u osam različitih podneblja sveta – u centralnoj i severnoj Evropi, na Balkanu, u ruskim i azijskim predelima kao i u starom Rimu. Jedno neobično, zapravo općinjavajući zanosno putovanje duha! Ako teatar ne može menjati svet, sasvim sigurno može ga oplemenjivati u šta će gledaoci predstava ovog festivala svakako imati priliku da se uvere.

## 16<sup>TH</sup> EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL THEATRE FESTIVAL SLAVIJA 2017

### XVI INTERNATIONAL THEATRE FESTIVAL „SLAVIJA“ 2017

Every year, at dusk of early spring, on 9 March, the International Theatre Festival „Slavija“ begins, presenting the selected performances by theatre ensembles from different parts of the world. The spectators have got used to the fact that the Festival programme is not determined by topic or style, or confined in any programme orientation, nor does it favour any search for new trends at any cost, or experimental performances. To put it simply, it is a festival of good performances, created after the dramatic text of confirmed values, most often from the pens of famous authors. That is why we can say this year, too, that the „Slavija“ Festival will enable the viewers to watch the pieces of the famous world playwrights, performed on the stages of eight countries. Already in the first festival evening, on 9 March, the Russian Academic Youth Theatre from Rostov on Don, will present a piece that has never been presented on our stages, written by a contemporary French playwright, Erich Emanuel Schmidt - *Monsieur Ibrahim*, which is about the adventures of a boy on his trip from Paris to Istanbul. In the second evening, on 10 March, the Republic Theatre of Belarus Drama, Minsk, will present a piece by the famous Swedish playwright August Strindberg *Pelican*. This is a piece from the author's cycle of chamber dramas, which has never been performed in our country. Therefore, we can say that the beginning of the Festival is marked by repertory exclusivity.

The third festival performance, which will be given on 11 March, has been based on the rich tradition of the oriental theatre of shadows. Theatre "Barish", Maragheh, Iran, will present the performance *Shadows and the Wind*, by Fereydon Velaei, who is the author and director. This is a joyful play of the protagonist with his own shadow, which deals with numerous existential problems of the contemporary man. In the fourth evening, on 12 March, we will remain in the world of great literature. The Experimental Drama Theatre of Nationalities, Moscow will perform on that day, and present the story by Fyodor Dostoyevsky *Dream of a Ridiculous Man*, whose hero is involved in solving the existential problems that are topical even today.

In the fifth evening, on 13 March, the Festival host, "Slavija" Theatre will present a new performance on its repertory – a drama by the most important Serbian comedian, Branislav Dj. Nušić *The Heartless Woman*, which can be regarded as a surrealistic drama experiment, which is proved successfully on the stage by the director, Slavenko Saletović. In the next festival evening, on 14 March, the State Drama Theatre „Stoyan Bachvarov“, Varna, will present the performance *the One-Eyed King* by the contemporary Spanish playwright Mark Crehuet, which deals with the issues of the contemporary political life.

In the seventh festival evening, on 15 March, the Estonian theatre R.A.A.M., Tallinn, presents a piece by August Kitzberg *Werewolf*, which deals with the state of the spirit in a village, after a young woman, who was proclaimed witch, was burned. In the last, eighth evening of the 16<sup>th</sup> edition of the International Theatre Festival „Slavija“, the Zhambil Regional Russian Drama Theatre, Zhambil, Kazakhstan, will present the piece *Nero and I*, by Edward Radzinsky, which shows the Nero's brutal treatment of the conspirators who rose up against his bloody reign, and how this merciless ruler punishes them by death, forcing his teacher Seneca to watch the execution.

We will watch the dramas depicting life and conflicts in eight different regions of the world – in the Central and Northern Europe, in the Balkans, in the Russian and Asian regions, and in the ancient Rome. It is an unusual, in fact, stunningly fascinating journey of the spirit! If the Theatre cannot change the world, it can enrich it most definitely, and the viewers of the festival performances will be able to see that for themselves.

## XVI MEĐUNARODNI POZORIŠNI FESTIVAL „SLAVIJA“ 2017.

### TEMATSKA RAZNOVRSNOST I VISOK KVALITET

Svaki pozorišni festival sličan je originalnoj pozorišnoj predstavi u više činova. I dok gledalac u prvom slučaju sledi i očekuje da će u stilskom jedinstvu, doslednoj rediteljskoj postavci i više ili manje uverljivoj glumačkoj igri, dramska radnja, pa i sam svršetak biti logičan nastavak onoga što je u prvom činu bilo nagovušeno, u drugom slučaju gledalac biva zapljenut i zatečen tematskom raznovrsnošću, kao i ostalim kvalitetima pozorišne predstave: režijom, igrom glumaca, pa i samom opremom predstava. I upravo ta razlika čini pozorišni festival, a pogotovo pozorišni festival SLAVIJA 2017. izazovnom umetničkom senzacijom. Jer je sveko veće poseban umetnički doživljaj, a svi se opet sliju, zahvaljujući pažnji i značajeljiji koju gledaoци iz večeri u veče posvećuju pozorišnoj igri i umetnosti, a na uvek istoj sceni i u isto vreme. Otuda to jedinstvo mesta i vremena biva ona pupčana nit koja povezuje i osmišljava pozorišni festival SLAVIJA 2017. Draž je u kontinuitetu umetničkog doživljaja, ali i mogućnosti da se iz večeri u veče i uporeduju i vrednuju umetnički rezultati.

Pozorišni festival SLAVIJA 2017. nastavlja tradiciju da je međunarodni i da prikazuje predstave sa više kontinenata, što je svojevrstan prikaz različitih umetničkih senzibiliteta pozorišnih umetnika, od pisaca do glumaca predvođenih rediteljskom rukom i njihovih interpretacija karaktera. Ove godine će na ovom festivalu biti izvedene predstave iz Evrope i Azije, ukupno ostam predstava.

Medunarodni pozorišni festival SLAVIJA 2017. će biti otvoren predstavom GOSPODIN IBRAHIM, autora Erik-Emanuela Šmita, u rediteljskoj postavci Mihaila Zacea, Akademskog omladinskog pozorište iz Rostova na Donu, naravno iz Rusije.

Može biti da će ova filozofska priča o ljubavi i trpežnosti biti svojevrsni moto celog Festivala, jer će svakako, puna iskrenog humora, osvojiti srca i ostaviti gledaoca sa osmehom na licu i ponekom suzom. A smeh i suze su oduvek bile najdragocenija posledica pozorišnog čina.

Naredne, druge večeri se predstavlja Republičko pozorište beloruske drame iz Minska, Belorusija, i izvodi dramu velikog švedskog dramskog pisca Augusta Strindberga PELIKAN u režiji Aleksandra Gartsueva.

Ptica pelican, prelepa i tajanstvena, koja svoje ptice hrani sopstvenom krvlju, je metafora za lik majke i njene strašne obmane. Ostaje bolna dilema, kako će deca živeti sa tom novosaznatom istinom.

Treće večeri Pozorište „Bariš“ iz Maragheha, Iran, izvodi predstavu SENKE I VETAR autora Fereydon Velaeia koji je istovremeno i reditelj.

To je vesela igra bezimene osobe sa sopstvenom senkom, koja zalazi u dubinu ličnosti i otkriva beznadežnu usamljenost ljudskih bića. Bezimena ličnost je simbol savremenog čoveka sa svim njegovim dilemama. Predstava koja komunicira univerzalnim govorom pozorišne umetnosti.

Četvrte festivalske večeri Eksperimentalno dramsko pozorišne nacionalnosti, iz Moskve, Rusija, izvešće SAN SMEŠNOG ČOVEKA autora Fjodora Mihailoviča Dostojevskog, u režiji Sergeja Krajneva.

To je drama ljudskog duha, izražena u formi fantastike u kojoj se ovozemaljski homo sapiens borii sa svojim demonima i suočava sa sopstvenim strastima. To je svojevrsna apokalipsa ljudske duše.

Branislav Nušić, manje poznat kao pisac van svog komediografskog opusa će, pete večeri, biti predstavljen svojom nadrealističkom, ali i romantično etičkom, pozorišnom novelom, u adaptaciji dr Raška Jovanovića, ŽENA BEZ SRCA, Pozorišta SLAVIJA. Režiju potpisuje Slavenko Saletović.

Vredi zabeležiti opasku samog Slavenka Saletovića, režisera: "Možda ne moramo da imamo srce, ali ljubav će nam obezbediti život!"

Bugarsku će Državno dramsko pozorište "Stojan Bačvarov", iz Varne, predstavljati šeste festivalske večeri, izvođenjem JEDNOOKOG KRALJA, autora Mark Krehueta, u režiji Petra Denčeva.

Savremeni španski pisac Mark Krehuet, polazeći od bolno aktuelnih perifernih etičkih problema, tema političke odgovornosti i kroz svojevrsnu formu satire, prelazi u crnu komediju legalizovanog državnog nasilja.

Pozorište R.A.A.A.M. iz Talina, Estonija se, pretposlednje večeri Festivala predstavlja predstavom VUKODLAK, autora Avgusta Kicberga, u režiji Sergeja Potapova.

Prva asocijacija prilikom gledanja i doživljavanja ove predstave nesumnjivo ide ka mračnim vremenima inkvizicije: mlada žena je pogubljena pored crkve, pod optužbom da je veštica .... Međutim, iza nje ostaje devojčica, "dete veštice"... Ipak, ljubav trijumfuje!

Završno veče festival pripada Žambilijskom regionalnom ruskom dramskom pozorištu, iz Žambilja, Kazahstan. Oni će predstaviti komad Edvarda Radzinskog NERON I JA u režiji Kuandika Kasimova.

Autor nas враћa u rimske doba, u vreme vladavine ozloglašenog Nerona. U odnosu prema zaverenicima koje brutalno slama, do prisiljavanja svoga učitelja Seneke da gleda njegove zločine, kreće se radnja ovog filozofskog komada. Farsa o ljudskoj sudbini kao da se iz prošlosti reflektuje na aktuelne dogadaje! Sve se čini da onaj naslućeni moto, lajmotiv ovog XVI Međunarodnog pozorišnog festivala SLAVIJA 2017, o smehu i po kojoj suzi, može biti otelotvoren samim predstavama, pozorišnom igrom predstave koja se može učiniti kao igra u više činova, u kojoj se mešaju asocijativne svetlosti i umnožene asocijacije. Nijedna prošlost nije tako duboko pokopana da se ne bi, makar u nanosima, odrazila i na sadašnje vreme! A to je i etička i estetička sudbina teatra.

## 16<sup>TH</sup> EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL THEATRE FESTIVAL SLAVIJA 2017

### THEMATIC DIVERSITY AND HIGH QUALITY

Every theatre festival is like an original theatre performance in several acts. And while, with the first, the spectator watches and expects that in the stylistic unity, consistent directing, and more or less convincing acting, the dramatic action, and its very ending will be a logical continuation of what was suggested in the first act, with the latter, the spectator is overwhelmed by and surprised with a thematic diversity, and other qualities of the theatre performance: directing, acting, and the very setting of the performances. And it is precisely that difference which makes a theatre festival, and especially the Theatre Festival SLAVIJA 2017, a challenging artistic experience. Because, every evening we have a particular artistic experience, and yet, all of them blend, owing to the attention and curiosity of the viewers, from evening to evening, into the evening dedicated to the theatre performance and art, always on the same stage, at the same time. Hence, the unity of place and time becomes an umbilical cord that links and composes the Theatre Festival SLAVIJA 2017. The charm is in the continuity of the artistic experience but also in the possibility of comparing and evaluation the artistic results from evening to evening. The Theatre Festival SLAVIJA 2017 continues its tradition of being international, and presenting performances from several continents, and being a unique presentation of different artistic sensibilities of theatre artists, from playwrights to actors, led by the hand of the director and his interpretations of the characters. This year, the festival will present the performances from Europe and Asia, eight of them all in all.

The International Theatre Festival SLAVIJA 2017 will be opened by the performance MONSIEUR IBRAHIM, by the author Erich Emanuel Schmidt, directed by Mikhail Zaets, presented by the Academic Youth Theatre from Rostov on Don, of course from Russia.

This philosophical story about love and tolerance might become a kind of a motto of the entire Festival, because being full of genuine humour, it will definitely win the hearts and leave the viewers with a smile on their face and a few tears. And laughter and tears have always been the most precious consequence of the theatrical act.

In the next, second evening the Republic Theatre of Belarus Drama, Minsk, Belarus, will present a drama of the great playwright Augusta Strindberg, PELICAN, directed by Alexander Gartsuev.

The bird pelican, beautiful and mysterious, which feeds her chicks by her own blood, is a metaphor for the character of the mother and her horrible deception. A painful dilemma remains how her children will live with the newly found truth.

In the third evening, the "Barish" Theatre from Maragheh, Iran, will present the performance SHADOWS AND THE WIND, by the playwright Fereydon Velaei, who is a director at the same time.

This is a joyful play of a nameless person with his own shadow, which gets into the depth of self, and reveals desperate loneliness of human beings. The nameless person is a symbol of a modern man with all his dilemmas. The performance achieves communication by a universal speech of the theatrical art. In the fourth festival evening, the Experimental Drama Theatre of Nationality from Moscow, Russia, will present THE DREAM OF A RIDICULOUS MAN, by Fyodor Mihailovich Dostoyevsky, directed by Sergey Krainev.

This is a drama of the human spirit, expressed in the form of a science fiction, in which homo sapiens fights his own demons and passions. That is an apocalypse of the human soul.

Branislav Nušić, who is less known as a writer beyond his comedy opus, will be presented, in the fourth evening, by his surrealistic, but also romantically ethical theatre novella, in the adaptation of dr Raško Jovanović, THE HEARTLESS WOMAN, by the Theatre SLAVIJA. It is directed by Slavenko Saletović. The remark made by the director, Slavenko Saletović, is worth mentioning: "Maybe we do not need to have heart, but love will give life to us!"

The State Drama Theatre "Stoyan Bachvarov", from Varna, will represent Bulgaria in the sixth festival evening, by presenting THE ONE-EYED KING, by Mark Crehuet, directed by Peter Denchev.

The contemporary Spanish author, Mark Crehuet, starts from some painfully topical peripheral ethical problems – the topics of political responsibility, and moves through a form of a satire, to the black comedy about legalized state violence.

The Theatre R.A.A.A.M. from Tallinn, Estonia, will present, in the last but one festival evening, the performance WEREWOLF, by the author August Kitzberg, directed by Sergey Potapov.

When watching and experiencing this performance, the first association is related undoubtedly to the darkest period of inquisition: a young woman is executed by the church, under the accusation of being a witch.... However, a small girl, "the witch's child" lives after her... After all, the love triumphs!

The final festival evening belongs to the Zhambyl Regional Russian Theatre, Kazakhstan. They will present a piece by Edward Radzinsky NERO AND I, directed by Kuandik Kassymov.

The author brings us back to the Roman era, to the reign of infamous Nero. The plot of this philosophical piece moves from brutal treatment of conspirators, which he cracks down without mercy, to forcing his teacher Seneca to witness his crimes. It is a farce about the human destiny, which reflects from the past on the current events.

It seems that the presumed motto, the leitmotif of the 16<sup>th</sup> edition of the International theatre Festival SLAVIJA 2017, about the laughter and a few tears, can be embodied in the very performances, performing of the shows, which may seem as a play in several acts, in which associative lights and multiplied associations are combined. There is no past that can be buried deeply enough to prevent its reflection, at least in dunes, on the present times! And that is both ethical and esthetical destiny of the theatre.

“Pelican” is one of the latest chamber plays of the great Swedish playwright August Strindberg.

The main character Eliza, mother of the family, compares herself to a pelican, a beautiful and mysterious bird. According to the legend, in desperate situations, this bird feeds her chicks by her own blood. In reality, all the time, Eliza deceives her relatives, steals and betrays her husband, saves on children ....

Only at their father’s deathbed, did the children learn about their mother’s terrible deception. How are children going to live with this truth? How will these news influence the fate of the whole family?

Gradually, the world before his eyes turns into the fallen world, the same as the one on Earth, and the reason for the fall is the very hero of the story. The hero wakes up as a completely different man, who understands it is better to proliferate love and the good in the imperfect world, than vice versa ...

Ovaj žanr polazi od političke satire i pretvara se u crnu komediju o krhkosti naših ubedjenja, prirodi društvenih uloga i potrazi za istinom.

A family dinner at the policeman David's place. His wife Lidia has invited her childhood friend Sandra and her husband. He had lost an eye at a protest rally and the perpetrator turns out to be none other than the host... Contemporary Spanish playwright Marc Crehuet has chosen a side problem, a rather isolated case to make his characters collide. He throws them in a labyrinth of actions where they must yield their convictions or at least cave in. “The One-Eyed King” touches upon some painfully topical subjects of political responsibility, legalized state violence and the need for political foresight. The genre departs from political satire and turns into a black comedy about the fragility of our convictions, the nature of social roles and the quest for truth.

A young woman is executed aside the church. This is how director Sergey Potapov, also called "Yakutian Tarantino", starts his story of the "Werewolf".

All farmers from every corner of the parish were asked to watch the death of the witch. Men of the Tammaru household got back from the church in fear and bad mood. Suddenly they find a small tattered girl behind their door. This is the witch's child... For the first time, the word "werewolf" appears.

The family takes the little stranger to their house and life goes on as usual for many years. Until a young love bursts. The son of the family, Margus, falls for the stranger, Tiina.

This classic play by August Kitzberg tells the story of a relationship of "us" and "them", the crowd and individual, ordinary and exceptional. And the topic is more alive than ever.

And it is not just about the story, it is the way you see and feel it. It is the atmosphere, rhythms, movement and the words not said that brings the myth alive.




